Show Information

Deborah Boily's performances are Cabaret-style "one-woman" shows. Throughout her shows, Ms. Boily makes direct contact with the audience; therefore the shows are intended for the entertainment of audiences, rather than background music to be heard under a crowd. Ideally, her shows should be planned to accompany or follow a dessert course, if the event is a dinner show. If the event is of another type, Ms. Boily will meet with the event planner to discuss options and details for planning a successful event performance.

Ms. Boily's shows generally run for 30-45-60 minutes. Longer shows with two or three hours of music are available to and can be coordinated between Ms. Boily and the event planner. Clients' events and musical requests will be honored as possible, with the sincere intention to offer the most professional and entertaining evening for all.

Ms. Boily will supply her own accompanist, however, for non-local events, if a client wishes to supply an accompanist, Ms. Boily will agree to work with the accompanist under the following provisions: Ms. Boily must be able to ascertain the abilities and experience of the person and have sufficient time to rehearse with him or her to ensure a professional performance.

Deborah Boily has recorded four CDs. If it is appropriate to the occasion, she will request to sell her CDs at the event. Additionally, if the event is a fundraiser for the benefit of a nonprofit entity, Ms. Boily is also happy to offer her CDs as an auction item.

Equipment

The show will require the following: an acoustic or electronic keyboard (88 keys, ex: Kurtzweil); a sound system with one to two microphones; a monitor and speakers appropriate to the size of the venue. A sound technician is also requested to perform a sound check and to ensure professional sound throughout the performance.

Fees

Fees are commensurate with show length. The fee for a 60-minute show is \$ 3,000. Shows shorter than 60 minutes carry a minimum fee of \$2,000. Fees for events longer than one hour can be discussed and coordinated between Ms. Boily and the event planner.

Fees include payment for accompanists supplied by Ms. Boily and rehearsal time involved to prepare for the event.

Fees do not include travel or hotel outside of the Houston surrounding area. Ms. Boily will accept travel reimbursements for airfares, or air miles donated by a client. She also accepts being hosted in at a host's home in lieu of a hotel.
